**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE CUYAHOGA SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT AND THE NORTHEAST OHIO REGIONAL SEWER DISTRICT TO PROVIDE TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE REGARDING PUBLIC INFORMATION AND PUBLIC EDUCATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

Whereas, the City is required to annually provide for Public Involvement and Public Education (PIPE) pursuant to its Ohio EPA Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4) Discharge Permit; and

Whereas, the Cuyahoga Soil and Water Conservation District and the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District can provide such a public information program; and

Whereas, the cost of such a public information program for 2017 and 2018 is estimated to be Five Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$5,500.00) each year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, CUYAHOGA HOUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Cuyahoga Soil and Water Conservation District and the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District to provide technical assistance regarding public information and public education for the calendar years 2017 and 2018, a copy of said Memorandum of Understanding is being attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A", and incorporated herein as if fully rewritten.

Section 2. The cost of said public information program shall not exceed Five Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$5,500.00) annually without further action by this Council.

Section 3. It is recognized that some or all of said cost may be reimbursed to the City by the Sewer District pursuant to the Stormwater Management Program.

Section 4. That the Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Highland Heights for the further reason that the public education and information needs to begin immediately. It shall therefore take place immediately upon passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and approval by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.


