New Business:

1. Motion authorizing the purchase of office furniture and related equipment, from Alpha Office Supply, for use by the police department, in an amount not to exceed \$28,000.
2. Motion authorizing the purchase of health and fitness equipment from Health and Fitness Equipment Centers, for use by the fire department, in an amount not to exceed \$20,000.
3. Motion authorizing the purchase of computers, WiFi equipment, firewall and related equipment, from Lake Business, for use by the fire department, in an amount to exceed \$26,500.

4. Motion authorizing the purchase of computers, firewall and related equipment from TAC Computers, for use by the police department, in an amount not to exceed \$26,000.00
5. First Reading of Proposed Resolution 32-2023 authorizing a payment in an amount not to exceed \$20,000.00 to Envelope Consulting Services (ECS) for additional engineering and other professional expenses for the Police and fire Buildings and declaring an emergency.
