### Matters for Discussion

- Were any New Drainage reports/forms were received?
  - 682 Kenbridge Dr. – Karen Helffrich (2023-08-08)
  - Mr & Mrs in the audience – County came out for early July incident, County snaked and video storm line pipes out to the street. Replaced the lines. There was dye test. County coming out next week (21<sup>st</sup> 8-11am) for additional dye test. Looking for help to install something for future sale.
  - **Brian B** – will have staff at the home appointment. Discussed backflow preventor. Report from County will be available within 48 hours. Bob will follow up with homeowners after County testing next week.
  - **Brian B** – we have a list for the county to investigate, but it is usually after the fact.
- Calls from residents
  - Frank Fantozzi on behalf of Maria Fantozzi - 5627 Wilson Mills Road Highland Heights
  - Email that Bob was copied on, Ann also. County went out, on a heavy rain day. Agreed to clean out the creek/stream. There is a bridge – homeowner – on Miner they need permission from.
  - Discussion on what County will and will not maintain.
- Other
  - 894 Brainard Rd. Spoke with homeowner at state of City and advised to fill out a drainage report. Evan GiLombardo (sp?) spoke with Bob. Not form received yet. Bob stopped, no response from homeowner
  - Reimbursement Policy for Backflows
  - Miscellaneous (Ford Rd)
    - 1025 Ongoing storm sewer issue. History on previous creek that ran along Brainard and Ford. Discussion on storm sewer not being sufficient currently. Flooded basement, but thru the floor of basement, not building footers. Asking for storm sewers Lives next to advent church. Lived there for 22 years. Severe storms will infiltrate the basement. Brian M – asked where storm sewer outlets. Homeowner asked County to verify where they outlet.
    - Discussion on dollar amount to install enclosed storm sewer. Brian M – would be more than 1 Million to install.
    - 1025 Ford - Another homeowner discussing the inground pool ‘floating’ – installed a sump pump for the pool. Brian M – did they find the outlets, yes. Brian B has a report from the County regarding water in the house duct work (the house is on a slab). States that the swale would hold water. Chuck

– is there anything to do on a house to house issue? Brian M – no. Chuck – is there a program or grant to work on this? NEORSD, MSIT project.

- Brian M – homeowners need to maintain their swale. Homeowner suggested that there are others that have issues. Is there a way to enforce the cleaning of the swales?
