Matters for Discussion

- Were any New Drainage reports/forms were received? **No.**
  
- Calls from residents
  - 7/2/2021 - 669 Lander – Hilda Artino. Can City help with swale? Her landscaper maintains swale behind her house, neighbor on Jefferson does not. Charlie D will investigate week of 7/5/021. Letter sent. **From the Building Dept. visual inspection, most have been cleared.**
  - 7/2/2021 – 861 Stanwell - Steve Gallowan. Looking for an update on neighbor to the north that installed flower bed in swale. Survey done in 2019. Recent visit by Charlie D, 7/22/2021. Letters going out to multiple homes on Stanwell and Rose to clean swale. **Director Grabfelder will reach back to resident, and will attempt to contact resident with flower bed, perhaps landscaper to make improvements.**
  
- Roy / Renee area
  - Comments on proposed letter and handout
    - Ms Ganser – From visit by City Service Director, Building Director and Engineer – there is not much of a problem. It appears to be a problem during a rain event, not lingering.
    - Any correction would require multiple homeowners' concurrence and agreement.
  - Discussion on previous efforts
    - In 2019 – similar request came in. Letters were sent in November, with only two (2) residents responding. No further action was taken by the drainage committee then.
    - Director Grabfelder will look for previous letter.
  - Drainage Committee will review older letter, then discuss sending a follow up letter, or replying to current email's for the three (3) residents on the current request (6/14/21)
